

Club Uniform Requirements & Guidelines

Preamble

This document is intended for club officials who are acquiring uniforms (jerseys, pants, shorts, socks) for their club squads. Please also consult the Inline Hockey Ireland Safety Policy document for related uniform and equipment requirements.

Uniform Specifications

Clubs are required to have two sets of uniforms, a Home designated uniform, and an Away designated uniform. Clubs are required to have acquired Home and Away designated uniforms for the commencement of the 2011/2012 regular season (1st September 2011).

Clubs joining the league in the 2011/2012 season will be afforded the length of the season to acquire their away designated uniform. A home designated uniform will be required for the commencement of their first game.

There are two categories of uniform specifications, required and optional. Each club must follow the required specifications fully. The optional specifications can be incorporated if desired.

Anything not present within these specification categories must be passed by the Inline Hockey Ireland (IHI) Executive Committee before uniforms are sourced. See the Variances to Requirements and Guidelines section below.

Required Specifications

1. Coverage

1.1 The uniform's jersey must cover fully their arms and chest, covering their elbow pads and shoulder pads.

1.2 A uniform can consist of inline pants or shorts and socks.

1.3 Where inline pants are used the uniform's pants should cover the player's leg from the waist to the heel, covering over shin guards, girdles, and groin guards.

1.4 Where shorts and socks are used the uniform's shorts and socks must fully cover the players leg from the waist to the heel, covering over shin guards, girdles, and groin guards.

1.5 Inline pants are preferred over shorts and socks.

2. Color

2.1 The home designated jersey must consist of one colour (designated the club's primary colour) occupying at least 70% of the surface area of the jersey. This primary colour must not be white or close to white in colour. Three other colours, (second, third, and fourth) can occupy the remaining surface areas of the jersey.

2.2 The away designated jersey must consist of the colour white occupying at least 70% of the surface area of the jersey.

2.3 There are no colour requirements for pants, shorts, or socks currently.

3. Jersey Numbering

3.1 Each jersey shall have a jersey number on the back of the jersey, centered below the shoulders.

3.2 The colour of the jersey number must be white. Black, the second, third, or fourth colour can be used to border the number.

Optional

4. IHI Logo

4.1 The IHI logo may be present on a club jersey, provided the club is in good standing with IHI. Written permission and jersey design approval must be sought from the IHI Executive Committee before uniforms are sourced with the logo included. See the note below in this document for more information.

4.2 The IHI logo must be at least 10cm high, 10cm wide, and be present, unaltered, on the right breast of the jersey.

5. Club Logo

5.1 The club's logo may be present on the front of the jersey, centered in the stomach area, clear of the front jersey number (see section 9 below) and IHI logo (if present).

6. Player Name

6.1 A player may have their surname present on the back of the jersey, above the jersey number, centered between the shoulders.

6.2 The player's surname must be white in colour, with black, the second, third, or fourth colours bordering it.

6.3 Where there are two or more players within the same club with the same surname, use the initials of the player's first and second names to create a unique jersey name.

7. Club Name

7.1 The club name may be present on the back of the jersey, under and clear of the jersey number.

8. Sponsor Logo

8.1 Sponsor logo(s) may be present on any part of the jersey as long as they are not located, or cover any required specification.

9. Extra Jersey Numbering

9.1 Jerseys may have their jersey number located on the front of the jersey, located on the left breast.

9.2 Jerseys may have their jersey number located on the arms, located between the shoulder and elbow.

Variances to Requirements and Guidelines

Clubs can seek permission from IHI in the case where they would like a variance to any of the requirements and guidelines above. Clubs should apply in writing with their uniform design to the IHI Executive Committee for approval of their variance.

Uniform Purchase Suggested Practices

Uniforms are expensive to purchase and are usually discounted when bought in large quantities. It is suggested when making a purchase of uniforms to purchase more than are required at the time of purchasing. This will ensure uniforms are available to new recruits in clubs without having to do another, possibly expensive uniform purchase. Purchase these extra uniforms in multiple sizes with available player numbers. This will help ensure you have an available size and number for a new recruit.

Note

Where a club elects to put the IHI logo on their jersey (see Optional Specification 4) and is given permission to do so, the club will be eligible for a 10% rebate on the purchase price of each jersey which bears the logo (up to a maximum rebate of €75). Contact general.secretary@inlinehockeyireland.org to seek permission or for more information. Approval will be based on the club's standing with IHI and the design of the uniform.
